- 2) Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University has given a specific time period for the completion of admission process. You have to complete your admission within that period on or before 20/07/2023. Any delay on any account may cause irrecoverable damage to your academic career.
- 3) You, yourself have to fill in the admission form. Take care to fill in every column accurately.
- 4) You should be personally present while taking admission.
- 5) Students seeking admission to any stream of first year (i.e. B. A. I, B. Com.I, B.Sc.I) should carefully consider their liking for optional subjects and its importance in the practical world.
  - \* Our guidance will happily help you in making the choice of subjects or group of subjects.
  - \* Please note that the subjects once chosen and entered in the admission form can not be changed for any reason.
  - \* University may refuse your admission or you may be deprived from taking examination in the event of committing mistakes in this regard.
- 6) For the students seeking admission to second orthird year of B.A., B.Sc.: Subjects offered at the first year / first semester have to be offered for further semesters.
- 7) The groups of the subjects have been decided by the University.
- 8) You will get your identity card only after your admission is complete in all respects. You will get the identity card from the college library.
- 9) <u>DON'T FORGET</u> to get the receipt of the payment of fees. When you submit the admission form keep this receipt safe with you and produce this receipt on demand. No refund or any such matter can settled without original receipt.





# **General Discipline**

- Your behaviour must be in accordance with healthy academic working of the college. Any breach of discipline may invite cancellation of your admission from this college.
- 2) The Principal has all the powers with regard to annual gathering and other events. His/Her decision in these matters will be final. There will be no fishpond and no special meal during the annual gathering if it is decided to be organised.
- 3) You should go to the college office only when the office calls you or only when . It is absolutely necessary for you to visit the office. You should take care that you are not wasting time of the office staff. •
- 4) You should always carry your Identity Card with you and show it whenever you are required to show it. Your identity card should be attested by the Principal.
- 5) No student will try to bring any direct or indirect political or any other influence on the college staff.
- 6) The use of mobile phone is strictly prohibited in the class room and in the college premises, (except academic purpose.)
- 7) Any activity like ragging will be punished under Maharashtra Prohibition of Ragging Act. 1999.

### Attendance, Tests and Submission of Tutorials / Homework

- 1) It is compulsory for students to attend regular classes. The University has fixed 75 % attendance in classes to be eligible to take University Examinations. If your attendance falls short of this percentage, you will not be eligible to appear and attempt the University Exam.
- 2) Absence in one class will be treated as absence for the whole day.
- 3) The student must take part in all class tests and sessional works on the dates decided by the college /teacher. Absence in the tests leads to 'Failed' result in the end.
- 4) Students should submit homework of their subject promplty. (within time)
- 5) Students have to secure the passing marks under internal exams separately from the passing marks in the university exam. •
- 6) To avoid the problems and complications, consult the subject teacher for details without any hesitation.



# **Rules of Admission**

- 1) Students seeking admission to first year course obtaining 60 % or more marks at their H.S.C. examination will get direct admission. Students who have obtained less than 60 % marks at the H.S.C. examination will get admission according to number of seats available on merit basis.
- 2) Rules of reservation are applicable for admission. The quota of seats is as per the rules of Govt. of Maharashtra & Dr. B.A.M.U. Aurangabad.
- 3) If the seats reserved for the backward communities are not filled within the given period, the same shall be converted to open category seats.
- 4) Students with bad record in respect of behaviour, studies performance, discipline and regularity shall not be admitted.
- 5) The students must pay all fees including practical fees and other charges at the time of admission.
- 6) The students must not change the subjects or group of subjects he/ she has opted in the form after the admission is complete.
- 7) Admission given by the college is initially on the provisional basis & it will be considered final only afterthe approval of the University.
- 8) The Principal has the descritionary powers to make changes in the admission rules within the framework of the rules of the University and Govt. of Maharashtra.



# Eligibility for admission

### Qualification for admission to First year B.A., B.Sc. & B. Com.

According to University Circular SAD/NP58/1991-92, Dr. Babasahab Ambedkar Marathwada University, the students seeking admission to first year course of B.A., B.Sc. & B.Com. should have one of the following qualifications:

- 1) He/She should have passed one of the following.:
  - i) H.S.C.
  - ii) Equivalent to above or below mentioned two courses.
- a) He/She should have passed Diploma in Education (D.T.Ed.) examination with English as one of the subjects.
- b) He/She should have passed three year Diploma course in Engineering of Maharashtra State Board of Technical Education
- c) He/She should have passed Diploma course in Pharmacy (D. Pharm) approved by the Govt. of Maharashtra.
- d) He/She should have passed XII class exam H.S.C. of the vocational education Board with English as one of the subjects.



# **Necessary Documents for Admission**

Students should keep with them sufficient number of photo copies of their documents. The college will not give back the original documents and Transfer Certificate (T.C.) they are submitted with admission form.

- 2) Two Photo copies of Marks Memo 12<sup>th</sup> & 10<sup>th</sup> Standard.
- Original Migration Certificates(If you have studied in other University in the previous course.)
- 4) Photo copy of Caste Certificate.
- 5) Parent's Income Cerificate below 2,00,000/-.
- 6) Ex-serviceman Certificate if required.
- 7) Physically challanged Ceritificate if required.
- 8) Domicile Certificate xerox copy.
- 9) Adhar Card xerox copy.
- 10) E-MaillD
- 11) Passport Photo (2 copies)

### **Fees for Eligibility Certificate**

The students seeking admission to the I<sup>st</sup> year (semester I) course of this University have to get an eligibility certificate from the University. The Students should apply to the University through the College.

The fees for this certificate is as follows:

- a) Student who has passed HSC exam of the Aurangabad Board- Rs. 50/-
- b) Student who has passed HSC exam from the Maharashtra HSC Board other than Aurangabad Board-Rs. 100/-
- c) Student who has passed HSC exam from a Board out side Maharashtra Rs. 500/-
- d) Foreign Students- Rs. 12500/-

The Fees Structure is subject to change as per the instructions of the University.

The form for eligibility should be submitted along with an attested photo copy of your HSC examination and the migration certificate, (if necessary)

- 3) Six months Course Constitution of India is compulsory to B.A., B.SC. & B.Com first year students.

### **Rules for Libarary**

- 1) Identity Card is necessary to avail library facilities No library Facility shall be given to students without identity card.
- 2) Two books at a time can be given to students.
- 3) Students can keep library books for one week only. They will have to pay fine of Rs. 1 per book per day if they keep books for more than a week
- 4) Any attempt to damage the books will be treated as misconduct and in that event the student will have to pay recent full price of the book.
- 5) If the book is lost, the student will have to pay 2 times more than recent price of the book.
- 6) The students will have to return all the library books before the commencement of the University Exams.
- 7) If the student wishes to keep the book with him/her during the University exam period. He/She has to pay full recent price of the books as deposit to the librarian the in the library.
- 8) The student has to take 'Nodues' certificate from the library when applied for Transfer Certificate. (T.C.)
- 9) The Reading Hall of the library is meant for the study. The students should maintain pin-drop silence in the place.
- 10) In case of loss of rare books the students will have to replace the book or he/she Will have to pay the penalty as decided by the librarian.

# Freeship and Scholarships

# **Conditions for Freeship and Scholarships**

- 1) Student holding professional degree/diploma like D.Ed., Polytechnic Diploma, D.Pharmacy etc. is not eligible for these scholarships / freeships.
- 2) These scholarships are subject to approval of the authority concerned.
- 3) Students must produce gap certificate in case there is a gap in his education.
- 4) 75 % attendance in the classes is compulsory for all the scholarships, freeships and concessions.
- 5) Students comming from other district should produce the District Transfer Certificate by the District Social Welfare Office.
- 6) Students who fail the concession in the fee form the authority concerned will have to pay full college fees.
- 7) If the students have any difficulty or any complaint they should consult the chairman of B.C.Cell.







### Activities organised by the college

- 1) <u>Cultural Forum / Avishkar Cell:</u> This forum takes care of your urge to participate and develop the artistic side of your personality. This cofiege and its students have a reputation of making name in Youth Festival of the university and other activities. Dancing, acting, singing, debating, elocution are some of these arts.
- 2) <u>Sports Forum</u>: This is a forum through which the college has been able to send number of students to the state level and national level competitions. Many of them have won medals and awards and have benefitted in terms of jobs through this forum.
- 3) <u>NCC</u>: National Cadet Corps is a central Govt. facility for those who are interested in armed forces. Number of students have participated in Republic Day Parade of this college and have secured Jobs.
- **NSS:** National Service Scheme: This is a government sponsored scheme and the students get good grounding in the awareness of social problems through field work. It is a good training for social work also.
